Are you missing the right plug for your mobile phone charger or laptop? No worries! Our reception has a variety of adapters ready for you.

For anyone with allergies: If you have food sensitivities or special dietary needs like gluten or lactose intolerance, we're more than happy to provide alternatives. Just ask a staff member directly!

Library: If you're looking for a quiet spot to get some work done, our library is the perfect place! It's right above the fireplace room and has a cozy little work table with a lovely view of Lake Constance. Feel free to use this space for reading or to check out our collection of books on management, culture, history, and fiction.

Printer: The friendly reception team is happy to print your documents! You can either email the files to info@lilienberg.ch or bring them on a memory stick to the reception. We charge CHF 0.25 for each page.

NICE TO KNOW!

Pillows and duvets are provided in every room and are perfect for those with allergies. If you need extra pillows or duvets and can't find them in the wardrobe, just give the reception a call!

Ventilation To make sure your well-deserved sleep isn't interrupted by the pesky mosquitoes around Lake Constance, we suggest opening only the side windows and skylights that have mosquito nets.

Since our rooms don't have air conditioning, we like to close the shutters during the day in the summer.

The minibar with mineral water, cola, and beer is included in the room price.

Smoking: All rooms are smoke-free. We kindly ask that you enjoy smoking only outside, like on the balcony or terrace. An ashtray is available for your use there.

Umbrellas: You can spot umbrellas right by the entrance of every building.

National phone calls are part of the room rate. To reach another room, just dial 1 + the two-digit room number, like 101 (but remember, for room 12, it's 113, and for rooms 44 and 45, it's 145).

Valuables: Feel free to keep your valuables in our safe, which you can find at the reception office. Just make sure to check in at reception!



Free Wi-Fi (“Free-Lilienberg”) is available all around the house. You can connect using your mobile phone or credit card number. After that, you’ll get a code sent to you via SMS.

Laundry and ironing service: We're excited to help you with your laundry! You'll find a laundry bag and a price list in your wardrobe. Just leave the laundry bag on your bed with a little note telling us if you want your laundry washed or ironed. You'll get your laundry back by the next morning at the latest. Please keep in mind that we don't provide dry cleaning services here.

REPORT A FIRE If you see a fire, please use one of the push buttons in the hallway or let the reception know by calling 100 or +41 (0)71 663 2100.


GETTING TO SAFETY In the hotel section, you can exit the building through the hotel entrance on the ground floor, or you can head outside on the upper floor through the entrance to the Sonnenhof (that's the door to the right of the elevator). In the seminar section, you can leave the building through the foyer. In the Lilienberg Center and the Lindeguet, you can step out of your room onto the terrace.

EXTINGUISHER ATTEMPT Only if you are safe!

You can spot them between rooms 14 and 15, and also in between the

Rooms 24 and 25 are equipped with a wall hydrant and a fire extinguisher. In the seminar wing, you can spot fire extinguishers and wall hydrants in every corridor. At the Lilienberg Center, there's a fire extinguisher right at the entrance and a wall hydrant located on the first floor beneath the stairs. In the Lindeguet building, you'll find a fire extinguisher and a wall hydrant at the entrance to the underground parking garage.


Please throw away your trash in the special bin. You can find it right at the entrance of the indoor swimming pool building.


